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Project goal

To teach terminal skills to 120 youngsters, aged 19 to 21 years old.

Program

Vopak India helped develop and teach an integrated curriculum for around 120 youngsters, aged 19 to 21 years old, to teach them terminal skills, including SHE, Operations and Infrastructure Development. The project is named *Utkarsh*, which is Hindi for to grow, to rise or to elevate.



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What has been realized so far

More than 130 final year university students have participated in terminal skills training related to specific modules, including SHE (Safety, Health and Environment), operations, terminal infrastructure and maintenance. To this end, a 30 contact hours curriculum has been designed that includes theory, practicum and field exposure provided by faculty and industry experts. A field visit of students was organized for the students to expose them to the practical know-how of terminal operations. An examination was conducted. Four students were shortlisted for a terminal visit in Singapore and have got an understanding of a different business environment and have gained insight in cultural differences.
