Program

The SPV2 team is working with a school in Pengerang to equip the students with better skills and to expose them to different options for their future careers. Central to the project is improving their English language proficiency, as language is still a barrier in this remote Malaysian fishermen community.

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What has been realized so far

The Sekolah Menengah Tanjung Datuk (SMKTD) high school in Pengerang has been adopted by the project team. Activities include taking the students on field trips and letting them attend talks in different disciplines. The students were exposed to the world outside Pengerang during visits to an English newspaper publishing company, a university, an international school and a Vopak terminal. In addition to organizing English classes and workshops, the project team has also upgraded the facilities in their English Lab (with laptops, a printer, Microsoft Office software for students, a projector, a sound system, air-conditioning units and an internet connection. In addition, English corners have been installed in class and the library has received extra English books.
